



ODP Player Commitment and Financial Policy

ODP POLICY: regarding Commitment of Players Selected: It is expressly understood by all players and their parents/guardians that once selected to the program, they are responsible for all fees associated with the program. **No refunds will be given once accepted and registered to the program should a player elect not to participate.** It is further understood that players are expected to participate in all training sessions and designated Olympic Development Events including, but not limited to, tournaments, scrimmages, College Night and Region 1 ODP camp. It is further understood that players must notify their team administrator at least one month prior to an upcoming event if they do not want to be considered for the event. Upon selection to an upcoming event; **once the player accepts the invitation to participate, the player is responsible for all fees associated with that event.** A player who changes her/his mind, or cannot attend because of any other kind of conflict **is still responsible for the full amount of that event fee.** Players may only be relieved of their obligations with the permission of the Vice President of the Olympic Development Program.

Players will not be eligible to play in an event unless all ODP fees are paid in full. Players with existing balances may request they be allowed to pay their ODP fees on a budgeted payment plan. The decision to allow for payment of outstanding balances is that of the VP of ODP. In order for the request to be considered, a parent **must** agree to an auto debit from a Credit Card or similar account. (Note: A limited amount of potential financial aid exists for players with demonstrated need and information regarding this is contained in other SRI ODP documents.)

PLAYERS ATTENDANCE RESPONSIBILITY: Please make a note that it is the player's responsibility to travel to every event (training, game and tournament) with a ball, all training shirts, and full uniform. If SRI supplies vans or other transportation with seatbelts, players who refuse to wear a seatbelt will be sent home immediately.

INJURY: If a player is injured, and cannot attend a practice session or other event, it is important that he/she notify the team administrator so that this can be so noted on the attendance record. If a player is injured during an ODP training session or event, the player must advise the team administrator and coach of the incident.

UNIFORMS: Uniforms (or parts of the package) can be ordered at the beginning of the year when completing the registration process. If a player loses a part of the uniform and needs to replace it, she/he can contact the SRI office to see if a replacement is available. While the uniform supplied at registration at a discounted price, if a player reorders, it is likely that the price will be considerably higher.

PAST DUE FEES: A player with ODP fees that are past due (over 60 days), who has not made an attempt to work out a repayment plan, will be placed in bad standing until such time as the financial obligation has been resolved. Players placed in bad standing will be prohibited from participating with their club teams in games or tournaments.
