



Director of Coaching Role Overview:

Bellevue United FC is a non-profit organization that has provided soccer opportunities to our community for several decades. At Bellevue United FC our mission is to provide all youth the opportunity to play the world's game of soccer.

The Bellevue United Director of Coaching is responsible for the day-to-day management of coaching and player development initiatives for the club.

Role Description:

- Coach one Select team.
- Manage all coaches for the BUFC Select program. Responsible for tracking coaching retention and success.
- Identify and recruit new coaches into BUFC's Select program.
- Observe and evaluate training sessions or games for the BUFC Select program.
- Conduct in-season and end of season coaching evaluations for coaches in the BUFC Select program.
- Oversee and supervise all of BUFC's player development initiatives and philosophies.
- Present a draft of player initiatives and philosophies to the Board by the end of January and for Select Coaches by the end of February.
- Develop, curate, and oversee the delivery of BUFC select and rec curriculum.
- Present a draft of Rec player initiatives and philosophies to the Board during the April Board Meeting.
- Act as a liaison for BUFC as necessary during any meetings, events, or functions.
- Coordinate coaching development, including organizing and implementing coaching clinics for coaches of all levels (Micro, Recreational, and Select)
- Help organize and supervise Select tryouts. In partnership with Executive Director and Board, provide a comprehensive tryout implementation plan one month prior to the beginning of tryouts.
- Provide a comprehensive Director of Coaching report to the Board of Directors on a quarterly basis.
- Attend all scheduled board meetings.
- Conduct parent meetings after tryouts/team selection.
- Assist coaches with resolving any parent and/or player disputes across the Select program as a first point of contact if the parent cannot or does not feel comfortable resolving with coach. Escalate to BUFC president as needed.
- Assess the Select teams and advocate for them to be properly placed in the appropriate league/level (e.g. RCL, PSPL, etc.).



- Recommend, review, and approve tournament selections to ensure proper team/player development.
- Conduct and implement coaches' meetings.
 - 4 for Select (Pre and Post Tryouts, Pre-Fall Season, and Pre-State Cup).
 - 1 for the Recreational program including Micro and Mod after the teams have been formed.
- Help identify talent and ensure they have all the necessary information regarding the player pathway.
- Responsible for tracking player retention and success.
- Ensure programs are current with best practices.
- Interface with the Sounders and Reign regarding coaching and training opportunities and training related programs.
- Hold at least a C Level license.

Existing and Net New Programs

- Coordinate with Executive Director and Board to market, communicate, and register kids for existing programs such as 2v2, Futsal, and Spring Training.
- Work with Executive Director of Coaching to develop net new programs, eg after school kick-arounds.
