- Minimum USSF D license, USC National diploma, or foreign equivalents.
- Minimum of 1 years coaching experience with youth, any level.
- 5 years + playing experience; club/ high school or colligate.
- Understanding and knowledge of USSF, Washington Youth Soccer, NPSL league.
- Professionalism, enthusiasm, punctuality and responsibility.
- Strong communication skills
- Clear background check.
