



Iowa Soccer League Rules and Policies

PART III

ORGANIZATION

301: Divisions

Section 1: The ISL will be comprised of two (2) Divisions. These Divisions will be known as the Girls Division and Boys Division.

Section 2: Girls teams may play in the Boys Division.

302: Tiers

Section 1: At the discretion of the competitive committee, and in the interest of competitive play, any division U11 to U19 may be divided into 2, or more, distinct tiers.

- U11 and U12 will be placed into East and West divisions to minimize travel

Section 2: If divided into tiers:

- Tier 1 provides the highest level of league play and player development at the state level.
- Tier 2 and below are for the competitive and developing teams not yet at the level of Tier 1.

303: Age Divisions

- Age divisions- U11 (East and West), U12 (East and West), U13, U14, Combined U15-U16, and combined U17-U19 will be offered for both boys and girls.
 - Competition committee reserves the right to combine divisions based on number of teams entered in the league.
 - U11 teams will only play against U11 teams in the fall
 - Division placement in the spring season for all divisions determined by fall results.
 - New teams to the league in Spring will be placed by competition committee

304: Organization Members

Each Member Team is entitled to one (1) vote at any League General Meeting.

Each Member Team may designate a team representative to attend meetings and place a vote for the Head Coach.

305: League Committee and Directors

The Officers of the ISL are the League Director and the League Committee members.

- The League Director may not vote.
- All other members of the Committee shall be entitled to one (1) vote.

306: Composition and General Authority

Section 1: The ISL is governed by the League Committee.

Section 2: The League Committee has the following authority:

- Authority to amend the rules and policies of the ISL. The League Committee may wish to have the entire membership vote on rules or policy change at the annual meeting but is not required to do so.
- Adoption of the budget of the ISL.
- Approve the final playing schedule as produced by the League Director.

307: Meetings

Section 1: The League Committee will meet at the following times for the listed purpose.

- No later than 3rd Sunday in July of the current year. This will be the League placement and scheduling meeting as well as dealing with any matters concerning the upcoming year's league play.
- No later than the end of the calendar year. This meeting will review the fall season and set dates for the spring season and tryouts.
- At any time deemed necessary by the League Director to resolve issues. A minimum one-week notice by confirmed communication is required. This meeting may take place by teleconference.

Section 2: All League Committee meetings are mandatory except emergency meetings where a simple majority is sufficient. There will be an automatic 100.00 dollars fine for the first missed meeting/400.00 dollars and possible suspension from the committee for the second meeting.

Section 3: A committee member may designate an alternate to attend the meeting in his/her place.

308: Annual Meeting

Section 1: The League Director shall hold an Annual Meeting (AM) after the conclusion of the fall season.

Section 2: The order of business at the AM shall be as follows.

- Call to Order
- Suggested Amendments to the Rules and Policies
- New Business
- Adjournment

309: Place of Meetings

Section 1: The League Director shall secure and inform all committee members at a minimum of two weeks prior to any scheduled meeting, the time and location of the meeting.

Section 2: The league AM will be held no later than the end of the calendar year.

Section 3: Meetings may be audio recorded by the League Director.
