



## 2016 Spring Venue Information

Thank you for hosting SRPL matches. Your support of the League is appreciated. Please review the information below about hosting. Please contact your PL Rep or League Administrator if you have questions.

### All venues must provide:

- Safe, quality, lined, full-sized soccer fields. Minimum size is 105 x 70, with corner flags.
- Grass mowed to an acceptable level.
- Anchored, full-sized goals on all fields.
- Functioning rest rooms on site.
- Adequate staff to manage the venue.
- A designated referee area.
- The facility must have a lightning detector and staff trained in the use of the equipment.
- The facility may operate a concession stand and keep all profits from the stand. At a minimum, water must be available for attendees and referees.

### Week of:

Prepare fields, check with referee assignor that games are covered and make sure you are ready to host. If you anticipate any problems - weather issues, lack of referees, etc. please contact Sharron Safriet at [ssafriet@usyouthsoccer](mailto:ssafriet@usyouthsoccer).

### In case of severe weather:

- Clear all fields and instruct everyone to go to safe areas – inside buildings, cars, etc.
- When severe weather passes get teams back on fields and resume games.  
Teams, referees, etc. are instructed to wait one hour before games will be declared completed – if in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. It is the intent of the League to get the matches played.

### Reimbursement policy:

All requests for reimbursement are to be submitted to the SRPL Administrator and must be accompanied by actual invoices where applicable and the Region 3 Direct Reimbursement Form. The form is posted on the SRPL3.com website/documents tab. All reimbursements must be submitted within 30 days of the event completion.

### Intrastate or one-off matches:

The SRPL does not pay field fees for Intrastate or one-off matches played at the home/league fields of one of the hosting teams unless approved when the match is scheduled.
