



The Desert Premier Division of the Far West Regional League uses the following club player pass rules:

- 1) For each game, a team may have up to five club pass players on the game roster. This means that five players that are not on the DP frozen team roster may play in each game.
- 2) For DP purposes, a club pass player is defined the same way it is defined in the NCS rules. Simply, a player must be registered to the same club as the DP team that he/she is playing for.
- 3) Referees, at game time, will be instructed that every player pass for each team, must have the same club affiliation. If a player's pass does not show the same club as the other players on the team, that player may not participate.
- 4) Any player that is not on the frozen Desert Premier roster (see roster freeze guidelines) will be counted as a club pass player, even if subsequently added to the state association roster.
- 5) No player may play for more than one team in the same day.
- 6) No player may play for more than one team in the same age/gender group in the same seasonal year.
