Dear Chris:

On behalf of the United States Soccer Federation, we are writing to confirm that the US Youth Soccer's State/Regional Select Teams are approved programs with U.S. Soccer's Olympic Development Program (ODP).

As you are aware, U.S. Soccer's ODP is a system in which players are identified, evaluated, and developed for possible inclusion in the U.S. National Teams and Olympic Teams. All of U.S. Soccer's ODP programs are approved by and operated in conjunction with the United States Olympic Committee.

Because some of your programs for high school-aged players may take place during the high school players seasons for certain states, those players wishing to participate will need an exemption from their high school association rules, which would prevent them from playing with an outside team.

We wish to thank you and all of US Youth Soccer for your continued support of this important process.
