

John Toebben – Hall of Fame

- ❑ Originally from Germany, John got involved in soccer when his children started playing recreational soccer in the early 1970's in Northern Kentucky.
- ❑ In 1975, he started soccer program at Covington High School and later coached at Covington Latin School till 1984.
- ❑ After coaching at the High School level, he moved to Thomas More College for three years and was named NAIA District 32 Coach of the Year in 1987 and 1989.
- ❑ In 1990, he became the men's soccer coach at Northern Kentucky University, a position he held until 2002. During that time, his team won three GLVC Championships and was named coach of the year twice.
- ❑ In 1995, he built the first indoor soccer facility in Northern Kentucky and two short years later, he built and developed Town & Country Sports Complex – a state of the art indoor/outdoor facility. Town and Country served as the home fields for both Thomas More and Northern Kentucky.
- ❑ John looked forward to spending time with his grandchildren, but unfortunately passed away at the age of 61 on April 26, 2003.
