

Keith Fuqua – Hall of Fame

- Became involved in soccer in 1984 when daughter Amy started playing and became fully entrenched four years later when son Josh starts playing with Owensboro Youth Soccer – he quickly became a coach and administrator.
- Was President of Owensboro Youth Soccer from 1989 – 1992 and was responsible for the expansion of Thomson-Berry Park from 3 fields to 10 fields through a sizable loan and matching federal grant.
- Served on the Kentucky Youth Soccer Board as District IV Commissioner, Secretary, Treasurer and Tournament Director from 1992 - 2001.
- Served as the age group coordinator for the Bluegrass State League.
- Retired from soccer in 2001 not seeking reelection at Kentucky Youth Soccer Tournament Director.
