Prior to his time at Georgetown College and Bluegrass Soccer Club, Willis coached at the high school level at Scott County High School and Central Hardin High School in Elizabethtown as well for Javanon Soccer Club and Atletico Flames Soccer Club.

No stranger to Kentucky Youth Soccer, Willis has been part of the Coaching Education Staff and ODP Coaching Staff since 2006.

"I am really excited to be a leadership position at Kentucky Youth Soccer," Willis said. "As a current ODP staff and coaching education staff member, I'm looking forward to expanding my responsibilities and growing the game in the Commonwealth. I would like to thank Kris Zander and Adrian Parrish for showing confidence in my abilities and giving me the opportunity to be a leader within Kentucky Youth Soccer."
