

PRESIDENTS CUP

13B (2004) – 14 teams with quarterfinals

3-3-4-4 (two cross-over divisions of three and two divisions of four)

In the 3 group cross-over division teams will play each team in the other division of three. The two divisions of four plays three games within their own group.

13G (2004) – 16 teams with quarterfinals

4-4-4-4 (4 divisions of 4)

The division of four plays three games within their respective division.

The top two point getters in each division advance to the quarterfinals.

14G (2003) – 19 teams with quarterfinals

4-5-5-5

The division of four plays three games and the divisions of five plays four games. The top two point getters out of each division will advance to the semifinals.

15G (2002) – 17 teams with quarterfinals

4-4-4-5

The divisions of four play three games and the divisions of five play four games. The top two point getters out of each division will advance to the semifinals.

16G (2001) 17 teams with quarterfinals

4-4-4-4 (4 divisions of 4)

The division of four plays three games within their respective division.

The top two point getters in each division advance to the quarterfinals.

17G (2000) 21 teams with quarterfinals

4-4-4-4-5

The divisions of four play three games and the division of five will play four games.

The top point getter from each division will advance to the quarterfinals and point averaging will be used for the three wild cards due to the one division having an additional game.

18G (1999) 10 teams with no quarterfinals

5-5 (two divisions of five teams)

Pool Play will consist of 4 games with the top two point getters in each division advancing to semifinals.

19G (1998) 8 games with no quarterfinals

4-4 (two divisions of four teams)

Pool Play will consist of three games with the top two point getters in each division advancing to semifinals.
