## March 26-29, 2015 @ ODP Sub-Regional Event

The Hawaii Youth Soccer Association is excited to announce the launch of the new HAWAII ODP!

HYSA is launching its new Olympic Development Program, which will feature two new age-specific Programs! Hawaii ODP is Hawaii's main pathway to U.S. Youth Soccer's Regional and National Teams. Hawaii ODP's new format will maximize development, identification and recruitment opportunities for Hawaii's players.

### PLAYER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (U12–U14)

**Mission.** The mission for the Player Development Program is to provide a comprehensive and consistent pathway to each players' development and progression through State, Regional and National levels.

**Hawaii State Pool.** Players selected to the State Pool will attend at least three Pool Training Camps between March and September. Players will be given technical, tactical and fitness homework, on which they will be evaluated at the following Pool Training Camp. New players will have an opportunity to try-out for the State Pool during the first session of each Pool Training Camp. Pool Training Camps will be held on different islands to allow easier access to try-outs for all players.

**Hawaii State Team.** The Hawaii State Team will travel to the ODP Championships each year. Only those players currently in the State Pool will be considered for selection onto the Hawaii State Team. The State Team will come together for at least two Team Training Camps prior to departing for the Championships.

### COLLEGIATE PREP PROGRAM (U15–U17)

**Mission.** The mission for the Collegiate Prep Program is to provide opportunities for college identification, recruitment and training for each player within the Program. Players will learn to navigate the recruitment process and maximize their chances for identification.

**Hawaii State Pool.** Players selected to the State Pool will attend organized College Training at which college coaches from the Mainland and Hawaii will work with players, and provide invaluable advice about the college recruitment process. New players will have the opportunity to try-out for the State Pool during the first session of the College Training. All players will be provided with regular written and/or oral evaluations from the college coaches during each College Training.

**Hawaii State Team.** The Collegiate Prep Program will be eligible to travel to ODP Championships. However, the formation of a State Team will be at the sole discretion of the State Coach. If a State Team is formed, players will come together for at least two Training Camps prior to departing for Championships.

## The Sub-Regional Event

**Sub-Regional Events.** The Sub-Regional Event is Hawaii's main recruiting event for State, Regional and National Team coaches. From each Sub-Regional event, players can be selected into the State Pool and invited to the ODP Regional Camp. In some cases, players have been selected directly to the National Camp from the Sub-Regional Event. **Starting in 2016, only those players who remain in the Hawaii State Pool will be invited to attend the ODP Sub-Regional Event.**
