



2019 Tournament of Champions Check-in Information



We are excited for the 2019 Mazzio's Tournament of Champions!

We have two opportunities for teams to check in. Early check-in will be at both the Tulsa and OKC office on Thursday, October 10th from 10am – 6 pm. Teams may also check in Saturday, October 12th onsite at North OKC SC from 7am to 12pm. Teams (coaches or managers only) should arrive a minimum of 1 hour prior to their first game to check-in.

The following is required for check-in:

We will have OSA Tournament rosters for all teams at check-in.

- OSA/USYS laminated player passes for all teams U11 and up with pictures.
- Coaches must have a copy of the registration form with medical release on it or a separate medical release for all players ([Medical Release Form](#))
- Coaches must have access to a copy of each player's birth certificate in case age verification is required.
- Secondary, or CPP players are not eligible and if any were listed on roster, those players have been removed from the TOC event roster only for this weekend of tournament games.
- All coaches must have a coach's pass with approved risk management status or a KIDSAFE pass (printed from the coach's profile or by club). Only coaches/managers with approved player pass will be allowed in the coaches box on the team side of the field.
- Guest Players are allowed for recreational and academy teams. Rec Select teams may not have any guest players per TOC rules. Please make sure you have two copies of the approved guest player form ([Tournament Guest Player form](#)) along with a copy of the team roster that the guest player is listed on as a primary player as well as a copy of the player pass (for U11 and above players).

All players of a team must be in the same color uniform. Please bring an alternate color and/or target jerseys in case of conflict.

Coaches, the 50% playing rule will still be in effect for all recreational and rec plus teams.
