

League Divisions with Two Groups

For Advanced Leagues, there may be two groups in a Division (Such as Boys U13 ASL Division 1 or Girls U16 ASL Division 2)) that you have been placed in. Each Group will be named “Sub-DivA” or “Sub-DivB” with no differentiation regarding the Groups other than naming convention. Based on seeding of the teams, distribution to each sub division has taken place and teams will “play across” versus the other Sub-Division. **First place of both Sub-Divisions will qualify under existing rules for league placement and Cup seeding will be decided based on tie-breaker rules.**

Each Group has 5 teams and the results of Season 1 will result in the following:

Division XX Sub-DivA	Division XX Sub-DivB
1 st Place is guaranteed at minimum the same place next season assuming player continuity	1 st Place is guaranteed at minimum the same place next season assuming player continuity

For example, 1st place in ASL Division 1 Sub-DivA and Sub-DivB will both be granted at minimum a league spot in ASL D1 for the 2019-2020 season.

* Advanced Leagues current Rules Section 4.02 and Appendix A addresses Promotion and Relegation as well as earned spots.

Hopefully this provides clarity as we look to support fair and competitive placement.
