

League Divisions with Two Groups

For Port of Subs Open League Season 1, there may be two groups in a Division (Such as Boys U11 Division 1) that you have been placed in. Each Group will be named “WHITE” or “BLUE” with no differentiation regarding the Groups other than naming convention. Overall for the age group, this means that Division XX (For example 1) White and XX (For example 1) Blue will have the next Division below it as Division ZZ (For example 3).

Each Group has 7 teams and the results of Season 1 will result in the following placements in Season 2 of Port of Subs Open League.

Division XX (For example Division 1 Season 2)	Division YY (For example Division 2 Season 2)
1 st Place from White	4 th place from White or Blue with next highest points
1 st Place from Blue	5 th Place from Blue
2 nd Place from Blue	5 th Place from White
2 nd Place from White	6 th Place from White
3 rd Place from White	6 th Place from Blue
3 rd Place from Blue	1 st Place from Division ZZ (For example Division 3)
4 th place from White or Blue with highest points	2 nd Place from Division ZZ (For example Division 3)

For example, 7th place in Division 1 White and Division 1 Blue will be placed in Division 3 for Season 2.

*As indicated in Port of Subs Open League Rules Section 4, Promotion and Relegation process takes place. Advanced Leagues current Rules Section 4.02 addresses Promotion and Relegation with POSOL.

Hopefully this provides clarity as we look to support fair and competitive placement.
