



Game Day – Management

The following are the required Game Day expectations:

1. Match balls are provided by the Home Team.
2. Site Coordinators shall report game scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner. In situations where no site director is available, the home team is required to report the scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner (See Below). Official Score Cards must be submitted to the AYSA office within 24 hours following the completion of each game.
3. It is expected that that the first team listed on the match schedule is to wear light/white color jerseys and socks. When there is a conflict in uniform color, the team listed first on the APL schedule must change its jerseys and socks --refer to Team Uniform Policy (Appendix G – APL Rules).

GAME DAY - STANDARDS

The following are the minimum standards expected for APL games.

1. No more than 2 games will be played on a given week unless special circumstances are required.
2. Weekday games can be scheduled.
3. Games will be scheduled in the Fall and Spring.
 - a. 12U –14U:
 - i. August 29 through November 18, 2018 (no games in December)
 - ii. January 11 through March 24, 2019
 - b. 15U– 19U:
 - i. August 29 through November 18, 2018
 - ii. Games will not be played in March unless re-scheduling requires it due to unforeseen circumstances.
4. U15 – Friendlies will be scheduled during December – January for those teams requesting games.

5. Top Class Playing Fields (12U-19U): The playing field must be among the best fields in the geographic area, and must allow the ball to run smoothly on the surface. Turf or natural grass is acceptable.
6. Athletic Trainers may be assigned for APL games.
7. Referee Procedures: The APL assignor is expected to be diligent in attempting to obtain the best referee's in the area. The APL assignor must provide the document, "APL Referee Procedures," available on the ASA APL webpage to all referees doing APL games.
8. Video Filming and Photography – ALL filming and photography must be approved by the League Commissioner.
9. NO TOLERANCE for poor sideline behavior!

REPORTING SCORES

~~It is the Home team responsibility to call the final game score into GotSoccer using the phone number, Event ID and Pin# listed at the top of the game card. Once completed, scan the completed score card and email to advancedleagues@azyouthsoccer.org or deliver to the ASA office no later than 48 hours after the completed game, or the game may be scored as a forfeit against the home team.~~

UPDATE 10/12: Teams no longer are required to report scores. Send in the game card following your game.
