

## **ASL Game Day – Management**

## The following are the required Game Day expectations:

- 1. Match balls are provided by the Home Team.
- 2. Site Coordinators shall report game scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner. In situations where no site director is available, the home team is required to report the scores in a manner determined by the League Commissioner (See Below). Official Score Cards must be submitted to the ASA office within 24 hours following the completion of each game.
- It is expected that that the first team listed on the match schedule is to wear light/white color jerseys and socks. When there is a conflict in uniform color, the team listed first on the ASL schedule must change its jerseys and socks --refer to Team Uniform Policy (Appendix G – ASL Rules).

## **GAME DAY - STANDARDS**

The following are the minimum standards expected for ASL games.

- 1. No more than 2 games will be played on a given week unless special circumstances are required.
- 2. Weekday games can be scheduled.
- 3. Games will be scheduled in the Fall and Spring.
  - a. 12U –14U:
    - i. August 29 through November 18, 2018 (no games in December)
    - ii. January 11 through March 24, 2019
  - b. 15U-19U:
    - i. August 29 through November 18, 2018
    - ii. Games will not be played in March unless re-scheduling requires it due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 4. U15 Friendlies will be scheduled during December January for those teams requesting games.
- 5. Quality Playing Fields (12U-19U): Turf or natural grass is acceptable.

- 6. Athletic Trainers may be assigned for APL games.
- 7. Referee Procedures: The ASL assignor is expected to be diligent in attempting to obtain the best referee's in the area.
- 8. Video Filming and Photography ALL filming and photography must be approved by the League Commissioner.
- 9. NO TOLERANCE for poor sideline behavior!

## **REPORTING SCORES**

It is the Home team responsibility to call the final game score into GotSoccer using the phone number, Event ID and Pin# listed at the top of the game card. Once completed, scan the completed score card and email to <a href="mailto:advancedleagues@azyouthsoccer.org">advancedleagues@azyouthsoccer.org</a> or deliver the completed score card to the ASA office no later than 48 hours after the completed game, or the game may be scored as a forfeit against the home team. UPDATE 10/12: Teams no longer are required to report scores. Send in the game card following your game.
