



Colorado Soccer Association - Referee Pay Rates & Game Processing

The pay rates effective August 1, 2016, and applies to all CSA-governed matches, including advanced league play (CO Champions League, Centennial League, Front Range League, Mountain Region League, President's Cup & State Cup). The pay structure includes:

Base Referee Compensation Increase - This increase applies across the board to all officials throughout the state, and is structured as shown in the table below.

Game Level	Referee Pay	Assistant Referee Pay
U11 – U12	\$30.00	\$20.00
U13 – U14	\$37.00	\$25.00
U15 – U16	\$45.00	\$31.00
U17 – U19	\$55.00	\$35.00

Premium Pay for Advanced-Grade Referees - Experienced, high-performance referees that meet the physical fitness and assessment requirements to advance in grade, and continue to meet the annual maintenance requirements to stay in grade (or have in the past for a sustained number of years), are compensated accordingly. These officials are paid a premium per match, (for their expertise and experience) regardless of the position or age bracket officiated. The premiums are shown in the table below.

Referee Grade	Per-Match Premium (Any Position)
International Referee (Grade 01) or International Assistant Referee (Grade 02)	\$40.00
Professional (Grade 03), National (Grade 04), or National Emeritus (Grades 13 and 14)	\$30.00
National Candidate (Grade 05), State (Grade 06), or State Emeritus (Grades 15 and 16)	\$20.00
Grade 07	\$10.00

Solo-Referee Bonus Pay - When a referee fails to appear for an assigned match, it places an undue burden on the officials who arrive as scheduled. In rare circumstances where two officials fail to appear as scheduled, the referee must officiate the game alone - commonly called an iron-man. In addition to his or her usual duties, the referee must also make offside and match-critical goal line decisions. This involves substantial additional running, increased multi-tasking, and increased need to focus on any additional tasks imposed. To compensate officials for extra (and usually unexpected) work for a scheduled three-official match, the bonus pay for solo-referee duty is shown in the table below: 9v9 games shall be assigned 1 referee. Exception – AR's may be added if all other small-sided games are covered. Grade 9 & Grade 8 certified referees must work center referee positions.

Note – the processing date is not the date that you will see payment in your GOPay account. Games are processed, submitted to league/clubs for funding & referees can expect to receive payment via GOPay, add 3 – 5 days for funding by clubs/league & the 3 – 5 business days for fund to be clear and show in your GOPay accounts.

Referee payments for State Cup & President's Cup – processed 2 times during competition - after final pool play games & after final championship games.
