

# Field Development Committees Information Sheet



## ***The State Committee***

The State Committee will be made up of 5 or 7 individuals who will oversee the work of the regional committees. The members of the committee will be a source of information, experience, and direction to the regional committee members as they look for potential field sites and negotiate leases with cities, private land owners, and other entities. The state committee will review preliminary site proposals and recommend for approval at the UYSA board level.

## ***The Legacy Fields Regional Committees***

Each UYSA region will form a committee consisting of 5 or 7 individuals. The region committees will have the following responsibilities and expectations:

- Search for potential field sites within the region
- Meet with cities, private land owners, and other entities to negotiate legacy field partnerships
- Review and analyze region Legacy Fund monies in relation to prospective partnerships
- Meet monthly as a committee to discuss options and vote on site proposals to pursue
- Prepare preliminary site proposals and submit to State Committee
- Report monthly to the State Committee to give updates on progress within their region
- Solicit donations, matching funds, grants and other financial opportunities within the region

## ***Terms***

Terms will be 3 years for the first 3 members of the committee and 2 years for the next 2 or 4 members. There are no term limits.

## ***Selection Process***

1. Applications will be filled out and submitted to the UYSA State Office
2. The State Office will compile and send applications to the appropriate region director
3. The Region director will make selection recommendations to the UYSA board.
4. UYSA board will approve final applicants

Committees will be approved by the board at the April, 2016 UYSA board meeting
