

# First Registration Process for a U.S. Citizen

The International Clearance Process is required by FIFA and U.S. Soccer. All organizations affiliated with FIFA and U.S. Soccer are required to abide by FIFA's regulations.

A player born outside of the United States (U.S.) who is a U.S. citizen and who has never registered to play soccer at any level outside of the U.S. may be cleared by providing documentation detailed below.

FIFA requires a player born in a U.S. territory (Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, or the U.S. Virgin Islands) to be cleared. The territories have their own soccer federations and are viewed as foreign countries with regard to the international clearance process.

Submit the application and a copy of one of the following documents for the player:

- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- U.S. Citizenship Certificate

All information requested on the application must be provided; as required by U.S. Soccer. Once we receive a complete application package, the player will be cleared in several business days or less. North Texas Soccer will send an email to you to confirm that the player has been cleared.

Any document submitted must be submitted in its entirety; if a document includes several pages, please submit a copy of every page.

**A player born outside of the U.S. may not be added to a team's roster and may not participate in any games until the player has been cleared or until North Texas Soccer sends an email to you stating that the player may be added to a team's roster.**
