Who needs assessments?

- You will need formal match assessments if you are:
 - Upgrading from Grade 7 to 7D
 - Upgrading from Grade 7D to 6
 - Upgrading from Grade 6 to 5
- Maintaining your current Grade 7D, Grade 6, or Grade 5

What assessments do you need?

Referee Level	For Promotion	For Recertification
Grade 7D	1 x Referee and 1x AR on 16U competitive or higher, 17U recreational or higher or any full length adult match	1 x Referee on 16U competitive or higher, 17U recreational or higher or any full length adult match

Minimum passing score for these assessments is 70. Must be a sufficient test. Failing assessments must be made up by passing another like assessment. Two failing assessments in any upgrade cycle stops the current cycle.

What assessments do you need?

Referee Level	For Promotion	For Recertification
Grade 6	1 x Referee on U14 DA or higher, 17U competitive Division 2 or higher 1 x Referee on an adult Division 2 or higher match 1 x AR on either level above	1 x Referee on U14 DA or higher, 17U competitive Division 2 or higher 1 x Referee on an adult Division 2 or higher match

Minimum passing score for these assessments is 70. Must be a sufficient test. Failing assessments must be made up by passing another like assessment. Two failing assessments in any upgrade cycle stops the current cycle.

What assessments do you need?

Referee Level	For Promotion	For Recertification
Grade 5 (Referee must declare Referee or AR track)	3 x Referee or AR on U14 DA or higher, 17U competitive Division 1 or higher, adult Division 1 or higher matches	3 x Referee or AR on U14 DA or higher, 17U competitive Division 1 or higher, adult Division 1 or higher matches

Assessments must be completed by 3 different National Coaches.
Each must be an "Acceptable Performance" to pass.
Each assessment must provide a sufficient test of your skills.
Two failing assessments in any upgrade cycle stops the current cycle.

Can I request an AR assessment?

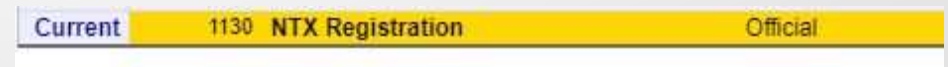
- AR assessments cannot be requested using the request system
- NTX Assessors are only assigned to Referee assessments
- You will need to find a match where a Referee is being assessed
- You will then be assessed as an Assistant Referee
- You can see Referee assessments that have been requested in the request system
- You can also work with your assignor to find matches that are being assessed – they will help you to upgrade if you work with them

What do you do first?

- Before requesting an assessment you must qualify for an assessment
 - Complete the appropriate advancement course
 - Complete the appropriate fitness test
 - Sign up and pay for your assessments

How to pay for your assessments

- Go NTX Game Officials
 - Sign in and press "Change Identity"
- Select Group 1130 – NTX Registration – Official
- Press "Courses"



How to pay for your assessments-2

- Press "Referee Courses"
- Press "GR x Upgrade or Maintenance Assessment"
- Register and pay your fee

What if you need don't see your course or you need an override code?

- If you don't see the course you need listed or you need an override code to register:
- Email the State Director of Assessments
- Email address is located on the ntxsoccer web page
- www.ntxsoccer.org/state_referee_committee/

After you have registered what next?

- Once you have registered for the course, email the SDA stating that you need to get an assessment arranged
- The SDA will create your profile in the request system
- Once the profile is created, you will receive an email stating you will be able to enter your assessment request

FAQs

- Will I know when an assessor is coming to my match?
 - No, just referee every match as if you are being assessed – you never know who may be watching
- What if the match details change?
 - Please email the SDA and call and text if it's a last minute change
- Can I be assessed out of State match?
 - If you are traveling to a tournament or match out of State, the State Director of Administration must be notified. Contact the SDA with the match specifics not less than 30 days from your trip
- Can I request an AR assessment?
 - No, see the earlier slide on this subject
- After my match, will I know if I have passed?
 - Yes, the assessor will tell you during the match re-brief unless there is an extremely unusual situation – you will be informed within 48 hrs
